We are happy to publish 4<sup>th</sup> quarter e-Newsletter (Volume - 51) for the period Oct, 2022 to Dec, 2022 furnishing the activities and achievements of the quarter focusing on sustainable agriculture practices, livelihood promotion of marginalized community, smallholder farmers, Women and Persons with Disabilities through on-farm, off-farm and non-farm activities emphasizing on climate-smart agriculture.

During the quarter, major focus was laid on Income & nutrition security of the tribal families through organic cultivation and consumption of Millets, Green Vegetables, Green leaves and sensitized the community on various value-added cooked foods with Ragi & other minor millets. Soil & Water conservation measures and drip irrigation has been adopted by the community. Apart from land based activities, the landless and other vulnerable communities & Persons with Disabilities were encouraged for income security through Goat & Chick rearing, seasonal business. Emphasis was laid on Institution strengthening like Ujayalla Farmers Producers' Company, Women cooperatives (Gajapati Women Cooperative & Mahendragiri Women Cooperative), women producers' groups and SAMARTH - an Organization of Persons with Disabilities.

We are very much thankful to Government of India, Govt. of Odisha and Project Funding Partners as well as our Board of Directors, Media friends and supporters.

**CENTRE FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (CCD)** 

SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOOD PROMOTION OF SMALL & MARGINAL TRIBAL FARMERS THROUGH IMPROVED AGRICULTURE PRACTICES ENSURING FOOD & NUTRITION SECURITY



CCD is always focusing on the improvement of livelihood and food & nutrition security through enhancing production and productivity of agro-horti produces by the tribal farmers. As an impact of regular capacity building and campaigns, the tribal farmers have adopted sustainable agriculture practices with organic farming. Major crops are Paddy, Ragi, Pulses and Vegetables grown by the tribal farmers in our operational areas in Gajapati District, Odisha. Emphasis was laidn on sustainable income generation as well as regular nutritious food consumption habits by the tribal families.



Crop cutting of Ragi was held at Gumma Block in 25 sqmt. The yield was 5.32 Kg i.e., an average yield per acre was 8.5 qtl. It was the fruitful achievement by the tribal farmers adopting SMI & Line Transplantation (LT) with agronomic practices. In the same locality, the farmers got the yield of 4 - 5 qtl of Ragi without adopting SMI and LT methods.

### Major achievements during the quarter


- Farm bund / stone bunding was held in 14.56 ha. of land by 73 smallholder farmers and wasteland developed by 45 smallholder farmers in 9 ha.
- 2. 218 farmers have cultivated Paddy, Ragi, Pulses, Vegetables like Tomato, Brinjal, Cauliflower, Radish, Chilli, Ridge Guard and Pumpkin and plantation of fruit bearing trees and Tuber crops.
- 3. 7 tribal farmers have transplanted Mango, Coconut, Guava, Sapota and Jackfruit in 3 ha. land for promotion of agro-forestry.
- 4. 60 families have promoted backyard nutri-garden adopting organic cultivation.
- 5. 33 farmers have cultivated different varieties of vegetables with bucket kit / drip irrigation.
- 6. 5 vulnerable / Persons with Disability families were supported 5 nos of breeding goats for income generation.
- 7. 85 families have promoted Model farm with multi cropping and transplanted Guava, Banana, Pomegranate, Lemon, Drumstick, Mango, Coconut & Jackfruit in 26 acres of land.







3 farmers have demonstrated Arjun varieties of Ragi in 0.25 ha of land. Wonderful result has come up. Earlier the farmers were using traditional Ragi seed and getting the yield of 15 - 17 qtl per hectare with the tiller rate was 2 - 4 nos. But in the experiment of Arjun variety of Ragi seed the farmers got the yield of 22 qtl per hectare wit 17 no. of tillers. They have exchanged the Arjun variety of seed to other farmers for upscaling.













During the reporting period the tribal farmers of Kurlandaguda have cultivated Paddy in 1.2 ha. by 6 farmers in the developed barren land without using any fertilizer inputs. As the trial basis they have cultivated Paddy. But their efforts were given fruitful result. The farmers got the yield of 18.75 qtl per ha. With total production of 22.50 qtl with good quality of Paddy from 1.2 ha. They are happy that their agriculture land holding capacity has increased and the income source sources also enhanced. They are planning to use the developed land with all type of crops with multi cropping using organic inputs. They have sold all 22.50 qtl of Paddy and got INR 45600

Backyard Nutri Garden is providing nutritious / organic vegetables for regular consumption as well as income opportunities. During the guarter 60 tribal families were supported quality seeds. The families got 80 Kg (average) of vegetables during the guarter. The households have used 60% of the organic vegetables for consumption purposes, rest of them sold at their village and also provided to their relatives to improve their consumption practices. Each family got the income of INR 4,000/ - in an average after consumption. Earlier they were purchasing the vegetables from the market which was not fresh and organic and high rate. Now the purchase from market is partially avoided and they have saved upto INR 3,000 to INR 3,500. So in an average their annual income has increased to INR 7,000. The families are happy to get the fresh and nutritious green vegetable and green leaves at their door step for regular consumption.

During the quarter 5 landless families / Persons with Disabilities were supported 4 breeding Goats and in this year total 47 landless, vulnerable and PwD families were supported. With their own contribution they have purchased 4 - 5 goats. Now 30 families have benefitted with 1 - 2 kids. Regular vaccination is going on with the interest of the community and the support of Veterinary Department. In this year some of the families have planned to sell the mother goat who has already given birth the Kids. It is expected Rs. 10000/- as an annual income will be earned by the Goat beneficiaries.







# Convergence support from ITDA, Gajapati under Mission Jeevika

51 tribal farmers from 8 villages of R.Udayagiri and Rayagada Block have received 51 nos of sprinklers for irrigation in their vegetable and other crop fields.

131 households have received 1310 chicks for income generation in 18 villages of Rayagada Block.



### **Women Empowerment & Micro Enterprise Promotion**

One of the important focus area of CCD is Women Empowerment and Micro enterprise promotion to enable the Women to get sustainable income and livelihood to live with self-reliant. To ensure financial inclusion, CCD is linking the Women self-help groups to the banks and women cooperatives and also encourage the Women to establish good liaisoning with Government department to mobilize financial support and other resources through convergence under Mission Jeevika-ITDA, Jeevika Mission-OLM and other line departments to enhance their household income. The women members of Gajapati Women Cooperative and Mahendragiri Women Cooperative have getting income opportunities through market linkage and selling of agro-horti and Non-Timber Forest Produces.

A mega training camp to women SHG members of Partada GP has been organized involving 151 women members. Government officials, Panchayatiraj Institution members, front line health workers, bankers have participated and encouraged the women members for financial inclusion, resource mobilization through convergence and ensuring sustainable livelihood & nutrition. The officials have assured to extend their full cooperation for sustainable livelihood promotion of tribals families focusing on vulnerable and marginalized families.





Two days District level workshop on FPO Management and Preparation of Business Development Plan was organized for Ujayalla Farmers Producers' Company Members and Management Staff. DDM, NABARD-Gajapati has participated and oriented on different schemes of NABARD. The Resource persons from Amanki Foundation Trust, Bhubaneswar have facilitated and imparted on the importance of the FPO.



10 days Rath campaign was organized in Gumma Block covering 115 villages in 17 GPs on the eve of Mandia Divas (Ragi Day) to sensitize the community on regular consumption of Millets. Surplus Ragi was sold at Mandi and got MSP of Rs. 3,578/- per Qtl. Mandia Divas along with Food festival has been organized by District and Block Administration to generate wider awareness on the nutritional value of Ragi and other Millets.

# Mainstreaming and Livelihood promotion of Persons with Disabilities and Vulnerable households

Mainstreaming of Persons with Disabilities is one of the priority core areas of CCD. The main focus area is strengthening of Community Based Organizations of Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) from Village to State level. CCD is following the Sustainable Development Goal that Leaving no one Behind and proving their voices that Nothing About Us Without Us.

#### CCD has adopted the following strategies for the mainstreaming of Persons with Disabilities

- Capacity building and make them aware of on different social security schemes of Government.
- Institution Strengthening from village to District level
- Creating Livelihood and Skill Development Opportunities for them
- Enabling Advocacy initiatives to access their Rights & Entitlements
- Therapeutic and Rehabilitative services for Children with Intellectual Disabilities
- Resource mobilization through convergence
- Financial Inclusion
- Inclusive Education

- Every month on 20th SAMARTH is organizing monthly network meeting to review the progress indicators of accessing rights & entitlements. Major focus was laid on Physiotherapy treatment for the Children with Intellectual Disabilities for their social rehabilitation. RBSK Manager from District Hospital has participated as the Chief Guest on 20th October, 2022.
- 15 PwD members were supported INR 3,00,000/- (INR 20,000/- each) to strengthen their existing micro enterprises and also establish new enterprise to assure their income security.
- 5 days residential training has been organized for 10 PwD members on Pickle making, hygienic preservation, packaging and marketing. The members have prepared and sold in their existing enterprises @ INR 60/- per 250 gm mixed vegetable pickle.
- Annual income is increased to Rs. 10000/- to Rs. 15000/- from seasonal business, goat rearing and chick rearing by the vulnerable families.

59 Children with Intellectual Disabilities are being provided Physiotherapy services by our Physiotherapist with necessary therapy equipments and also providing training to the Parents on different techniques of Therapy exercise so that they can able to continue the therapy services to their children atleast 3 - 4 times in a month. 20 Children have recovered by 40% - 80% With continuous Therapy services.





#### Physiotherapy is a hope for better diagnosis

Nandini karjee of Padasahi village, Rayagada Block of Gajapati, aged about 4 years old has been suffering with CP quadriplegia. After birth of Nandini, her parents could not pay attention on her physical movement and health development. Gradually Nandini's health condition was very complicated and she could not sit, stand, walk. Her physical movement was completely idle. Her parents tried a lot for better diagnosis from Doctor but due to poverty, they could not afford the expenses.

CCD has identified Nandini and for the last 3 years she is under physiotherapy treatment by our Physiotherapist. With the regular treatment for 3 – 4 times in a month, now physical improvement of Nandini is better. She can sit without support and standing with support of other persons atleast for 20 minutes with poor neck control and limited arm movements. He good sign of improvement is visible now and her family members, neighbour people feel very happy of her improvements and her parents are expecting for Nadini's recovery atleast of 50% - to 60%.

During the quarter CCD has supported INR 50,000 to 3 PwD members from its revolving fund for income generation. The PwD members are getting INR 250 to INR 500 per day from vending and other petty business.
