Sustainable Livelihood Promotion of Small & Marginal Tribal Farmers Through Odisha Millet Mission (OMM) by agronomic Practices



CCD is promoting Millet cultivation by Tribal farmers in Gumma & Kasinagar Blocks of Gajapati assenting on the improvement of livelihood and Food & nutrition security through enhancing production and productivity of Odisha Millet Mission adopting agronomic practices with organic farming. Emphasis was laid on sustainable income generation as well as regular nutritious food consumption habits by the tribal families, value addition of Millets to prepare nutritious food for consumption and establish a tiffin centre especially for millet items.

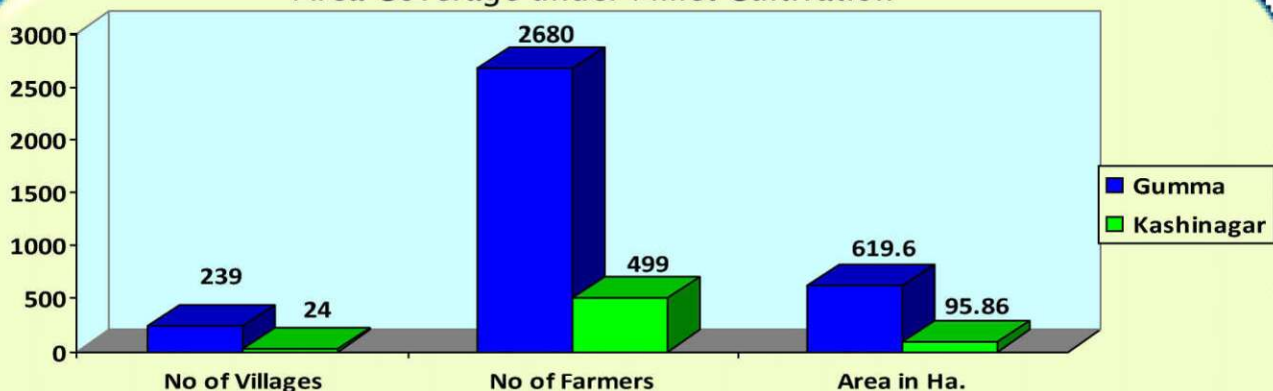




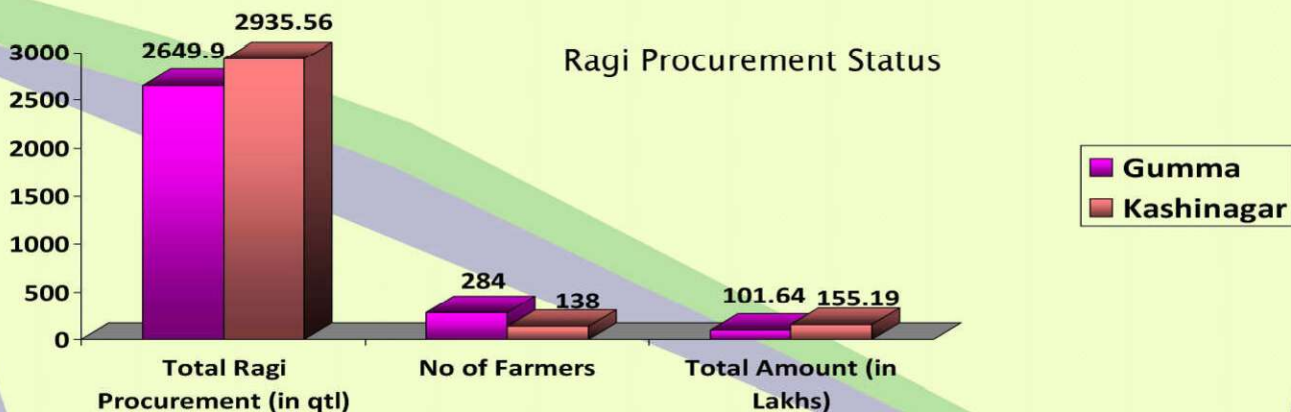

Sudipta SHG of Badakalakote is maintaining a millet tiffin centre and getting Rs. 126000 per annum. The household income the SHG members is Rs. 12600 (Average) per annum which is additional income.

- 20 vulnerable / landless families were provided 97 Goats (80 male goat & 17 female goats). 8 goats were sold @ Rs. 8000 each and got Rs. 64000
- Farm Bund / Earthen Bund constructed in 1.60 ha. by 6 tribal farmers. They are cultivating Paddy, Ragi, Vegetables and Cassava using Organic fertilizer and pesticides. After 30% consumption, the remaining 70% are being sold and got Rs. 15000 average.
- 23 farmers have promoted Pulses on the earthen bund and got Rs. 18000 average.
- Development of Fallow land in 0.92 ha by 6 tribal farmers have cultivated Paddy, Ragi, Vegetables and groundnut. The got Rs. 12000 average.
- Promotion of Agroforestry. Fruit & Vegetable cultivation 11.76ha by 16 tribal farmers. They got Rs. 3500 to Rs. 5000 average.
- 146 families were supported Nutrigarden / kitchen garden for consumption of organic vegetables.
- 20 landless / vulnerable families were supported 20 Bee Hives. 15 farmers have extracted 44 litre of Honey sold @ Rs. 600 per liter and got Rs. 26400.00
- 2 families have promoted Model Farm. They got seed and seedlings such as Mango, Guava, Coconut, Jackfruit, Banana and Lemon

Vegetable cultivation

Tribal families are continuing vegetable cultivation on the priority basis to get additional income and organic nutritious vegetables at least 9 months in a year. They have adopted organic compost and fertilizers. 240 families have taken up vegetable cultivation such as Brinjal, Tomato, long beans, bitter melon, long melon in 19.2 hectares of land. Each family is getting Rs. 5000/- to 7000/- per annum (in three times in a year). With the support of drip / bucket kit irrigation system, the families are cultivating vegetables in rabi – non-rain season i.e., two times in a year.

Apart from vegetable cultivation, the tribal families have established a Bee Keeping unit. The annual income is INR 2400 per family from the sale of honey.



CASE STUDY

Alternative family income through Bee Keeping

Junesh Gamango of Adeising village, Partada GP of Kashinagar Block, Gajapati is a landless farmer. He is having 2 Ac of Podu land and 0.05 Ac of Padar land where he is cultivating Cashew, Arhor and Little Millets. The income was very low. He has shown interest to establish a Bee Keeping unit. With the support of KKS – BMZ, he was supported with Bee hives, boxes (2 nos), Honey Extractor, smoker, stand and other required appliances. He has established a Bee Keeping unit in September, 2023. With the continued trainings, orientations he has well managed the unit. He has harvested 8 liters of honey in two phases (January –24 and April–24). He has sold @ Rs. 600 per liter and earned Rs. 4800/- which is the additional family income. He and his family are happy and all members are engaged in management of Bee Keeping unit. His aim is to improve the unit with more Bee boxes.



Women Empowerment and Micro enterprise Promotion

CCD has been prioritizing on Women Empowerment and Micro Enterprise promotion promoting and strengthening Women SHGs, Women Cooperatives, Women producer Groups to enable the women on marketing of agro-horti-NTF products at local market / Weekly haats. The Women cooperative is organizing capacity building trainings, savings & credit management as well as encourage the women groups for liaisoning with Banks, Odisha Livelihood Mission, ITDA and Gram panchayat level Federation to access to finance support for business activities.

During the period on Training to Women SHGs on SHG management & Participation organized by CCD – KKS where 48 women SHG members have participated. 313 SHG meetings organized at village level to orient them book keeping and bank linkages.

Training to women Hygiene, Health & Sanitation

Empower the women on health and hygiene, ensuring nutritious consumption CCD is always focusing on intake of Millet and non-Millet food for women, adolescents and children (under 5 years). Government of Odisha has initiated Poshan program.

Gajapati & Mahendragiri women cooperative members engaged in seasonal business and selling agro-horti and Non-Timber forest produces in local haat. The women cooperative is encouraging the members for capacity building as well as providing savings & credit facilities. Three producers groups have been promoted and liaisoning with Banks, government departments and Gram Panchayat Level Federation of Odisha Livelihood Mission to access to credit and business development



HEROS FOR HUMANITY

Supported by : Deasi Foundation Trust

CCD has been focusing on Health, Nutrition, Menstrual Hygiene and sanitation for the Women and Adolescent Girls capacitating them for health & hygiene management, nutritious food intake and protect them from various infections by sensitizing them for regular use of reusable biodegradable sanitary pads during puberty period. CCD is working in 120 tribal villages of Rayagada Block dividing in 3 clusters managed by 30 HEROs.

Apart from health and hygiene measures, the project is prioritizing on skill development of women and adolescent girls / youths for Computer Skill training and Sewing skill training to get regular income as well as promotion of micro enterprises.

CASE STUDY

Mrs. Ritarani Bhuyan resides in a remote tribal village where access to health care facilities are very limited. She is working as a daily labour and maintain her family. She has been suffering with joint pain and fatigue since past four years. With the low income, she could not get better treatment. As a result, she could not move and work properly. Her family became suffer with poor financial condition and here ability to work and earn was decreased gradually. She had been neglecting to take health care.



CCD has organized Geneeral Health Camp & Awareness Program with the support of Desai Foundation Trust and in this camp the villagers were provided free medical service including diagnostic test and medicines. Mrs. Ratarani Bhuyan attended in the camp and got medicines for joint pain and inflammation control including counseling on joint pain relief exercises and live with better lifestyle.

After two weeks of taking medicines and regular exercises, her joint pain reduced and performance of work ability has been improved. CCD is providing regular follow up consultation and medication refills to her and attending the Free General Health camps organized by CCD.



MAINSTREAMING PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

SAMARTH – is the District level Organization of Persons with Disabilities (OPD) promoted by CCD having 3015 Persons with Disability (PwD) members of Gajapati District working for socio-economic development and access to rights & entitlements through advocacy with Government stakeholders and other networks in Odisha.

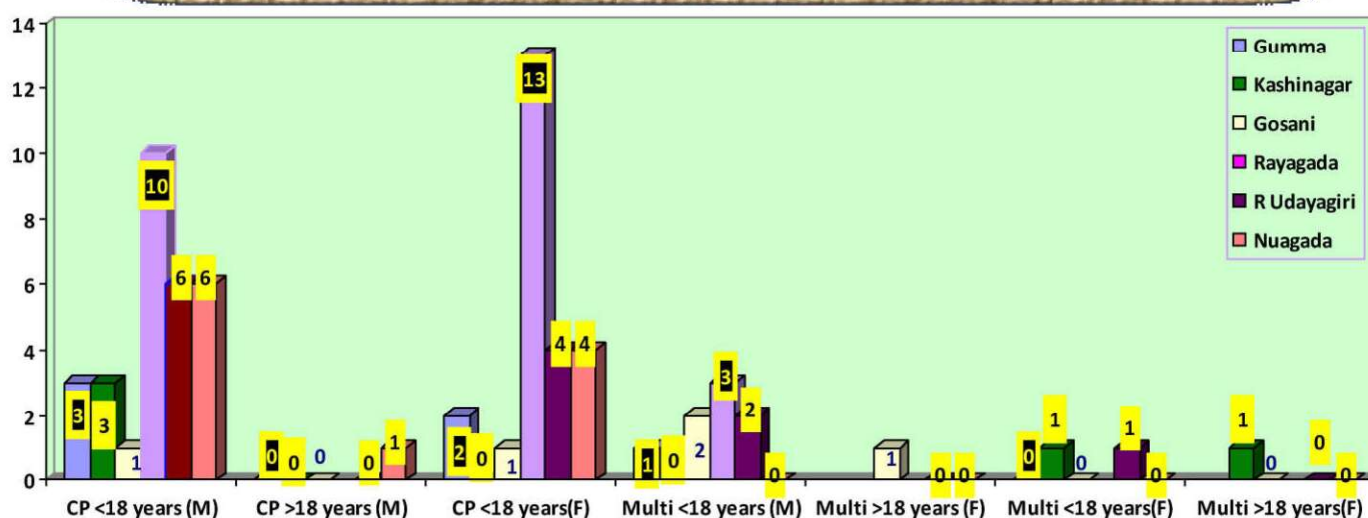
Therapeutic & Rehabilitative Services for the Children with Intellectual Disabilities

Supported by Social Security and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities Deptt., Govt. of Odisha

CCD has been providing Therapeutic & Rehabilitative Services for the 66 Children with Intellectual Disabilities in Gajapati District using necessary therapy equipments for the Children. The parents are being provided therapy exercise training on different techniques so that they are able to continue the therapy services to their children atleast 3 – 4 times in a month. 6 Children have recovered by 40% – 80% With continuous Therapy services by our Physiotherapist. If necessary, the experts from Government department are facilitating to provide Therapy exercise and technical assistance to the physiotherapist. Our Physiotherapy Ms. Sarojini Raito providing full concentration towards the children with Intellectual Disabilities and their family for their social development.

CASE STUDY

Dharmik Raita is a 10 years boy of Tarava, Gumma Block is a multiple disabled boy affected with Down syndrome and muscular dystrophy. Since childhood he was unable to walk properly and not able to do his Daily Living Activities by himself, parents were very much upset and worried for the child because he is the only son in the family.

In the year of 2021 CCD has identified him and make for the intervention plan and continued for physiotherapy treatment, last 3 years he is under physiotherapy treatment. Dharmik Raita is improved 60% of above all the conditions mention. Now he is studying up to 4th class in Village Government School. Dharmik is walking better than before and doing all the Daily Living Activities (ADL) independently. Now his family members are very happy seeing the improvement of Dharmik.

With the proper guidance of CCD-JSS Gajapati Personals, most of the Trainees have engaged in wage employment and self-employment after completion of their trainings from JSS-Gajapati. Some exemplary achievements have observed in the trade of Tailoring, Driving and beauty care, 90% of Trainees have got the Proper income source, self employment and settled them in the Society with the good monetary benefit.

Some of the qualified Trainees are now engaged as Resource Person and getting good income.



Protection of Child Rights Prevention of Child Trafficking

Supported by Kailash Satyarthi Child Foundation, USA

CCD has been working for Child Protection and Child Trafficking especially preventing Child Marriage, Child Labour in 50 villages of Rayagada Block of Gajapati District in collaboration with District Child Protection Officer, Police Personnel, Panchayatiraj Institutions, Community Based Organizations & Stakeholders prevention of Child marriage Act, POCSO Act, Child Labour Act, Right to Education and different Government schemes. Sensitization programs are going on at village level, schools, religious institutions, village level child protection committee, women Self-Help Groups, adolescents and youth leaders

During the reporting period, CCD has organized 19 no of Village meeting, SHG meeting, Adolescent Meeting and College level meeting. 207 male and 432 female members have participated.

Observation of Child Day has been organized where 50 male and 70 female members have participated.



Type of Cases : Child Marriage

One case found at Kashinagar Block, Gajapati. FIR has been lodged against the Bride and the Bride has been arrested by the Kashinagar Police.

One case found at Rayagada Block, Gajapati.. Undertaking was done by the Parents, AWW, ASHA and Community Leaders to stop the marriage and the marriage has been stopped.
